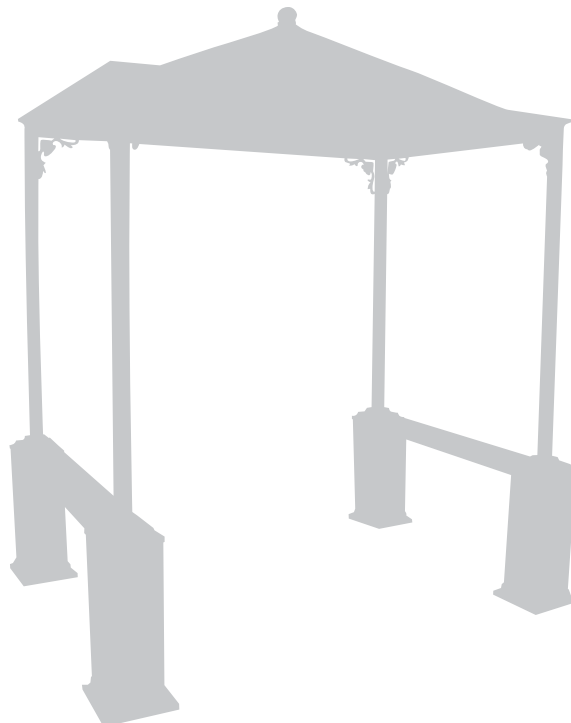

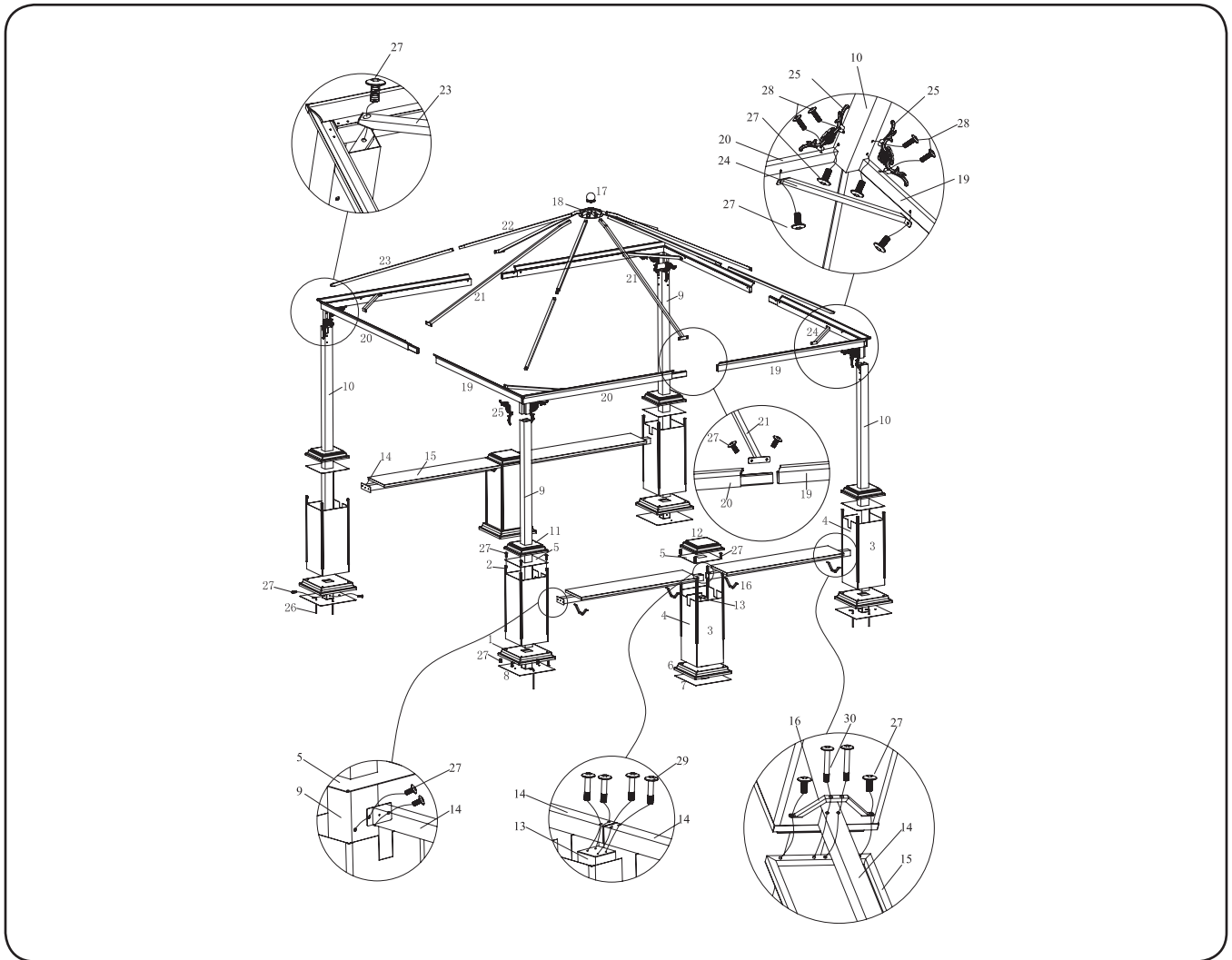

SPARTA GAZEBO SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

Warning! Please Read - Immediately!

- This Gazebo is manufactured to provide maximum protection from the sun.
- Do not leave Gazebo top on in any wind, rain, snow or inclement weather conditions.
- Do not use open flame under or near Gazebo.
- Do not hang materials or objects on or from Gazebo.

Tools Needed To Assemble:

- Cordless Drill/Screwdriver
- Ladders (2)

Important:

- Do not remove numbered stickers until set up is complete.
- Requires a minimum of 3 people to assist with assembly

BASE & SEAT ASSEMBLY

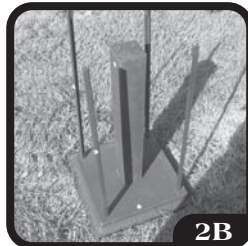
Step #1

Insert bottom plates – parts #7 & #8 – into posts – parts #9, 10, 13 - with small screws and secure (pic. #1). Repeat process for all posts.



Step #2

Place top post cover – part #1 – over posts – parts #9, 10, 13 (pic #2A). Attach base brackets – part #2 and secure (pic #2B) with small screws.



Step #3

Slide corner base plates and inner base plates – part #3 & #4 – into each base brackets covering the base post. Repeat this process for all posts (pic #3).

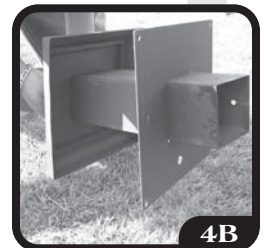


Step #4

Lift-up structure posts (4) – parts #9 & 10 – and insert base post cover – part #11 – onto structure post (pic #4A). Then insert post cover plate – part #5 – onto structure post



(pic #4B). Repeat this process for all posts. Secure all parts with medium screws.



Step #5

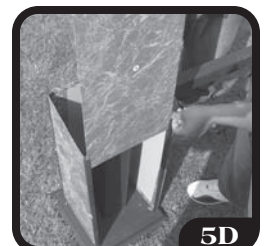
Assemble entire lower base post section onto structure post (pic #5A) – base plates will need to be removed and reassembled if necessary (pic #5B). Secure base posts with small screws (pic #5C).



Hold post cover plate and base post cover - parts #5 & 11, while inserting corner base plates - part #3 (pic #5D). Repeat process for all corners.



Place post cover plate onto face plates (pic #5E). Repeat this process for all posts. Secure all parts with small screws.

Step #6

Attach middle structure bar - part # 14 to base post - part # 13 (2). Secure with extended short screws (pic # 6). Repeat this process for both sides.



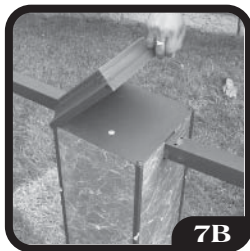

Step #7

Place post cover plate - part # 5 - onto middle posts (pic #7A). Place seat plate frame - part # 12 - onto seat plate cap (pic #7B) and secure.

Step #8

Place seat plates (4) - part # 15 - onto mid structure bars (pic #8A) and attach to frame. Secure with small screws and extended long screws. Place seat bracket - part #16 - underneath seat and secure with small screws (pic #8B).

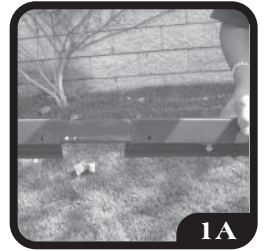

ROOF & FRAME ASSEMBLY

Step #1

Slide and insert ceiling frame bars - parts #19 & 20 into each other (pic #1A) and secure. Insert ceiling frame bars into structure posts - parts # 9 & 10 (pic #1B). Repeat this process for all posts. Secure all parts with small screws (pic #1C).

Step #2

Place decorative brackets (8) - part #25 - into each corner of the ceiling frame structure and secure with medium screws (pic #2).

Step #3

Align corner brackets - part # 24 - into each frame corner and secure with small screws (pic #3).



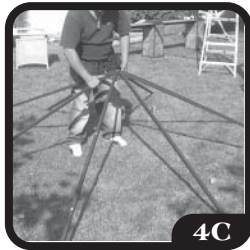
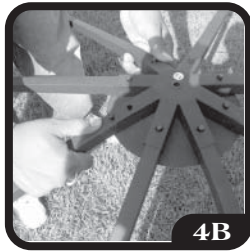
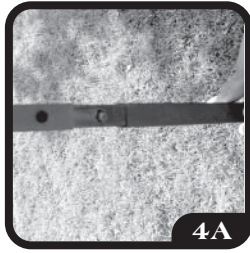

ROOF & FRAME ASSEMBLY

Step #4

Attach ceiling frame pieces - parts # 22 & 23 - (pic #4A) together and the bars formed from part # 22 & 23 into ceiling peak - part # 18. Attach ceiling support bars (4) - part # 21 (pic #4B). Secure push pins into frame structure (pic #4C).



Step #5

Lift the frame structure up onto base and seat assembly (pic #5A) and secure push pins in each corner of the ceiling frame base (pic #5B).



Step #6

Tighten and secure all small screws into the entire ceiling frame and support bars (pic #6).



Step #7

Drape the fabric cover - part # 31 over the ceiling frame structure (pic #7) and secure in the four corners of the frame.



Step #8

Place ceiling peak crown - part # 17 - through the top opening of the ceiling fabric and attached to ceiling frame peak (pic #8).



Step #9

Secure ceiling fabric to frame buttons by twisting in place (pic #9).



Step #10

Your Sparta Gazebo is now assembled for your enjoyment. (pic #10).
